Responsibilities (including but not limited to)

Operating and inspecting plant equipment, pump stations, and chlorination stations, performing process control tests and routine lab analyses, reading gauges and meters, adjusting process equipment to perform as specified, completing daily process control sheets, taking corrective action as necessary to keep facility equipment and processes functioning smoothly per plant standard operating procedures, performing routine inspection and maintenance at treatment facilities and pumping stations, performing backflow prevention device tests and cross-connection surveys, maintaining facility appearance and clean work areas, working the membrane filtration system, performing distribution system repairs, flushing, valve maintenance, snow plowing, fire hydrant maintenance, lawn mowing/weedwacking, recording data, meter repairs/replacements, and assisting other staff.
