The Monthly Meeting of the Board of Water Commissioners of the North Chelmsford Water District was held on November 23, 2020 at the Washington Street Office. The meeting was convened at 4:05 p.m. with Commissioners Bruce Clark, David Irvine and Robert Leavitt, and Superintendent Bruce Harper present.

Commissioner Irvine made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 2, 2020 Monthly Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Clark; the vote was unanimous.

We discussed the PFAS litigation and we signed the agreement.

We discussed Employee Benefits and we decided that if an employee has been on workers comp for a year or more the District will not pay for their licenses, incentives or longevity.

We discussed the Towns plan to move the North Fire Station temporally to the former DPW property at 54 Richardson Road during construction of a new fire station, even though at the Town Meeting in October they said that during construction the trucks and fire fighters would remain on site with temporary housing. We also discussed the Town moving the Fire Department mechanic to the former DPW site without giving notice to the Water District, we also spoke about Town testing of the site. Commissioner Leavitt made a motion to oppose the temporary Fire Station and to ask the Town to remove the Fire Department mechanic from the site immediately, seconded by Commissioner Clark, Commissioner Irvine abstained, the motion passed.

Bruce Harper spoke to Paul Howard about the PFAS at the former DPW site, and Paul highly recommended that no activity should be happening there.

Commissioner Irvine made a motion to adjourn at 5:10 p.m. seconded by Commissioner Leavitt; the vote was unanimous.
